

More Plural Nouns

The plural form of some nouns that end in **f** or **fe** is made by changing the **f** to **v** and adding **es**. For others, simply add **s**.

calf-----calves

muff-----muffs

The plural form of nouns ending in **o** is made by adding **s** or **es**.

rodeo-----rodeos

yo-yo-----yo-yos

zoo-----zoos

tomato-----tomatoes

Some plural nouns have special forms.

woman-----women

mouse-----mice

Some plural forms are the same as their singular forms.

moose-----moose

salmon-----salmon
